- Each student will have to submit preferences for the GE, GE Lang, SEC, VAC, and AEC papers as per their respective courses.
- Please read the description of each paper offered by clicking on the “Read Description” button below the Preferences field, before finalizing your preference.
- While making choices for the papers, students are advised to go through the eligibility conditions of UG course(s) under NEP as available on the Delhi University website (www.du.ac.in) or seek guidance from their teachers.
- The form will be submitted only ONCE and no request for change will be considered after the form is submitted. So please fill in your options carefully before but not later than the last date.

General Instructions for Generic Elective (GE) Course as per NEP/UGCF

- All students enrolled in B.A.(Hons.)/B.Sc.(Hons.)/B.Com.(H)/ B.Sc.(Prog) will have to opt for one GE course offered by the college. Students **CANNOT opt for the GE paper from their discipline/department**. For example, a student of B.Sc.(Hons) Mathematics CANNOT opt for the GE paper offered by the Mathematics department.

Instructions for Generic Elective Language (GE Lang-1) Course

All students enrolled in B.A. (Prog)/B.Com (Prog.) will have to opt for a GE Lang-1 course. In case you are a student who has one language as either Major

or Minor (non-major) subject, you will not be able to choose a GE Language offered by the respective language department.

1. B.A.(Prog): GE Lang-1 as Hindi

GE Language-1: Hindi Language (or Choose In Lieu of Language (ILL) if Hindi is your Major or Minor discipline)

Subjects offered In Lieu of Language (ILL): History/Political Science/Economics)

- However, in case you are a student who has Hindi language as either Major or Minor (Non-major) subject, THEN you will have to opt for a GE Lang course from the open pool. Please opt for GE courses as per the following notification:

2. B.Com.(Prog) Course: GE Lang 1 as English

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC):

- Students of all courses will opt for any one SEC course from the pool of SEC courses offered by the College.
- Students of all courses **preferably choose the SEC paper from their parent department.**

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC-1)

- All students of Semester I have to study an Ability Enhancement Course (AEC) in the first semester. There are two AEC courses — AEC-1 as Language or EVS-1.
- The College has divided the students into two groups.

AEC-1 as language course is offered only to B.Com.(Prog)/ B.A.(Prog)/ B.Sc.(Prog) with Chemistry/ B.Sc.(Prog) with Computer Science Students in Semester I.

Regarding the AEC Language Course

- The students have the option of studying any of the 22 Indian languages as AEC. The college offers AEC in Hindi and Sanskrit. In case you would like to study any of the Indian languages other than Hindi or Sanskrit please click "Any other" or "Cluster College" from the drop-down list and contact the admin office.
- Students are required to see the following weblink to see the syllabus and the eligibility criteria before exercising the option of filling for the language

- In the case of AEC-Language, other than Hindi and Sanskrit, classes will be held in a college of the Central Cluster offering the course, or outside the cluster in MIL depending on the availability of course. The languages offered by the colleges of the Central Cluster are: Urdu (A,B,C), Punjabi (A,B,C), Bengali (A, B), Tamil (A, B). For languages outside the Central Cluster the classes will be held in the MIL Department. Please note that the Attendance Record, Practical Record, Internal Assessment Records are maintained by the college/ Department in which classes are held and not by the parent college.
- For **AEC languages** Hindi and Sanskrit as per the University rule you have to choose
 1. Hindi A-If you have studied Hindi till Class 12th
 2. Hindi B-If you have studied Hindi till Class 10th
 3. Hindi C-If you have studied Hindi till Class 8th
 4. Hindi D-If you are a Foreign student
 5. Hindi E-For those Indian students who have NOT studied Hindi till 8th.
 6. Sanskrit A-If you have studied Sanskrit till Class 12th
 7. Sanskrit B-If you have studied Sanskrit till Class 10th
 8. Sanskrit C-If you have studied Sanskrit in 8th class or have not studied Sanskrit in school at all.

Regarding AEC-1 as EVS

All students of B.A.(Hons) / B.Sc.(Hons) /B.Com.(Hons) will be offered EVS-1 in semester I.

 2. B.A. Economics(Hons)
 3. B.A. English(Hons)
 4. B.A. Hindi(Hons)

General Instructions for Generic Elective (GE)/Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course as per NEP/UGCF

- As per NEP structure Semester III students can opt for either **GE** or **DSE (NOT BOTH)**. Please note as per NEP a student may opt for a DSE from their department, but CANNOT opt for a GE from their parent department.
- Further, as per NEP, a student can opt for a DSE from another department. In case a student opts for the DSE of a department other than their parent department, it will be considered as a GE course.

Instructions for Generic Elective (GE) Course for Honours courses

Students enrolled in B.A.(Hons.)/B.Sc.(Hons.)/B.Com.(H) will have to opt for one GE from a pool of **GE Courses** offered by the college. Students **CANNOT opt for the GE paper from their discipline/department**. For example, a student of B.Sc.(Hons) Mathematics CANNOT opt for the GE paper offered by the Mathematics department.

Discipline Specific Elective (DSE) Course for B.Sc.(Prog) courses

Students enrolled in **B.Sc.(Prog)** will have to opt for **one DSE** from a pool of DSE courses offered by the college.

However, in case a student wants to study a DSE course, it can be chosen from the list of DSE papers offered by the parent departments as well.

Instructions for Generic Elective Language-2 (GE Lang-2) Course for B.A.(Prog) and B.Com(Prog) courses

B.Com.(Prog): GE Language-2 : English-II

B.A.(Prog) GE Language-2: Hindi-II/Sanskrit-II/ ILL-II

In case you are a student who **does not** have any language paper as either Major or Minor (non-major) subject, you will have to choose only from the list of the general pool of GE courses. You will have to choose GE Lang-2 of the language studied in Semester-1.

- However, in case you are a student who has one language as either Major or Minor (Non-major) subject, and you studied the correct GE Lang-2 in semester 3 then you will have to choose part-II of the GE Lang-1 studied in Semester-1.
- In case you have GE Lang-2, same as your major or minor paper **ONLY THEN** you will have to opt for a GE course from the open pool. You will not be able to choose a GE course offered by the respective language department. Please opt for GE courses as per the following notification:

- However, in case you are a student who has one language(Hindi) as either Major or Minor (non-major) subject, and you studied the GE from the OPEN POOL in Semesters I, then you will have to opt for PART-II of the GE Lang-2 course you studied in Semester-III. Skill Enhancement Course (SEC):

- Students of all courses will opt for any one SEC course from the pool of SEC courses offered by the College **except** the SEC studied by the students in Semesters 1, and 2. **It is the responsibility of students to ensure that they do not opt for any SEC paper already studied by them in previous Semesters (1, or 2).**
- Students of all courses **preferably choose the SEC paper from their parent department.**

Ability Enhancement Course (AEC)

- All students of Semester III have to study an Ability Enhancement course (AEC-2) in the 3rd semester. There are two AEC courses—AEC Language-2 and EVS-2.
- The College has divided the students into two groups.

1. **AEC language-2** course is offered only to B.Com.(Prog)/ B.A.(Prog)/ B.Sc.(Prog) with Chemistry/ B.Sc.(Prog) with Computer Science students in semester III
 2. EVS-2 : All B.A.(Hons) / B.Sc.(Hons) /B.Com(Hons) students will be studying EVS-2 in semester III.
 3. Kindly refer to the eligibility criteria mentioned in the syllabus on the University website before choosing the AEC Languages.
- Languages chosen by the students shall be in continuation with the language studied in Semester 1 i.e. a student must opt for Part II of the AEC-2 language studied in Semester 1.

- All **Semester-V** student's have to opt for both – one GE and one DSE paper.
- Please note as per NEP a student should opt for a DSE from their department, and opt a GE paper from a department which is not their parent department.
- Further, as per NEP, a student can opt for a DSE from another department. In case a student opts for the DSE of a department other than their parent department, it will be considered as a GE course.

Instructions for Generic Elective (GE)

- Students enrolled in B.A.(Hons)/B.Sc.(Hons)/B.Com.(Hons), B.Sc.(Prog)/B.A.(Prog), and B.Com.(Prog) courses will have to opt for either **one GE** from a pool of GE courses offered by the college. Students **CANNOT opt for the GE paper from the same discipline/department**. For example, a student of B.Sc. (Hons) Mathematics CANNOT opt for the GE paper offered by the Mathematics department. For example, a student of B.A.(Prog) having discipline papers such as Political Science and History CANNOT OPT for the GE paper offered by the Political Science and History departments.

Instructions for Discipline Specific Elective (DSE)

- Students enrolled in B.A.(Prog)/ B.Sc.(Phy.Sc)/ B.Sc.(Hons)/ B.Com.(Hons)/ B.A.(Hons)/ B.Com.(Prog) courses will have to opt for **one DSE** from their core discipline. A **DSE** paper opted from a discipline/ or disciplines other than the parent discipline will be considered a **GE** paper.
- For example, a student of B.A.(Prog) having discipline papers such as Political Science and History can OPT for the one **DSE** paper offered by the either Political Science or History department.
- For example, a student of B.Sc.(Prog) having discipline papers such as Chemistry/ Computer Science, Mathematics, Physics can OPT for the one DSE paper offered by Chemistry/ or Computer Science, or Mathematics, or Physics department.

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC):

- Students of all courses will opt for any one SEC course from the pool of SEC courses offered by the College **except** the SEC studied by the students in previous Semesters. (1,2,3, or 4).
- Students of all courses **preferably choose the SEC paper from their parent department.**
- **NOTE: It is the responsibility of students to ensure that they do not opt for any SEC paper already studied by them in previous Semesters (1,2,3, or 4).**

Developing a Major and Minor for students of B.Sc.(Hons), B.Com.(Hons), B.A.(Hons) and B.Com.(Prog) :

III/IV Semester: Only GE paper should be provided to students of all honours courses and no DSE paper should be offered to students to get minor degree in GE

VII Semester: I DSC + 2 DSE + I GE + 1 Dissertation should be provided to all Hons students.

VIII Semester: I DSC + 2 DSE + I GE + 1 Dissertation should be provided to all Hons students.

Single core discipline programmes (Honours in 3 years) –

Core discipline – Major

7 GEs – Minor

Instructions for Discipline Specific Elective (DSE)

Students enrolled in B.Sc.(Hons)/ B.Com.(Hons)/ B.A.(Hons)/ B.Com.(Prog) courses will have to opt for **TWO DSE** from their core discipline. A DSE paper that originates from a discipline/ or disciplines other than the parent discipline will be considered a GE paper. These students will have to opt for one GE from a pool of GE courses offered by the college.

Option for 4th Year for Multi-core Programmes B.Sc.(Prog) and BA(Prog)

Students of B.A. (P) or B.Sc. (P) will get a simple degree after completion of 3rd year and an Honours degree after completion of 4th year.

B.A. (P) or B.Sc. (P) Students will not get 'Honours with Research' degree after completion of the 4th year even though such students write 'Dissertation' or do 'Academic Projects'.

B.A. (P) or B.Sc. (P) Students may therefore be given a choice of studying purely course work without having to do any of the three tracks envisaged (i.e. Dissertation/ Academic Project/ Entrepreneurship)

However, this facility cannot be extended to Single-core programme students, as they shall be getting 'Honours with Research' or 'Honours with entrepreneurship' after completion of 4th year.

Option for coursework instead of writing Dissertation/ academic Projects/ entrepreneurship may be open to the choice of students who are pursuing B.A. programmes and B.Sc Programmes.

BA(Prog) : Two-core discipline programmes (B.A. Programmes)

One of the core disciplines – **Major** (14 DSCs + 6 or more DSEs)

Other core discipline is '**Minor**' provided 28 credits are earned [6DSCs + 1 DSE (this DSE should be studied in the Vth Semester if the student wishes to go the 4th year so that DSE – RM [Major core discipline can be studied in the 6th semester]

Only for BA(Prog) Course: Major/Minor

VII Semester: 1 DSC in Major + 4 DSE in major (VII Seme) + 1 SEC (92 credits)

VIII Semester: 1 DSC in Major 4 DSE in major (VIII Seme) + 1 SEC

14 DSC in major + 1 DSE in major (VI seme) + 4 DSE in major (VII Seme) + 4 DSE in major (VIII seme) = 23 papers (92 credits in Major subject)

Three-core discipline Programmes (B.Sc. Programmes)

One of the three core disciplines – Major (8DSCs + 9DSEs)

Another one of the three core disciplines – Minor (6DSCs + 1DSE)

III/IV Semesters: Only the DSE paper is offered to students, and no GE paper is offered to students, so that students get a degree in Hons in DSE.

VII Semester: 1 DSC + 4 DSE + 1 SEC papers offered to students, no GE offered to students.

VIII Semester: 1 DSC + 4 DSE + 1 SEC papers offered to students, no GE offered to students.

(6 DSC(I-VI semester) + 4 DSE (III, IV, V & VI Semesters) + 1 DSC + 4 DSE(VII Semesters) + 1 DSC + 4 DSE (VIII Semester) = total 20 papers (students get 80 credits in one subject to get degree in Major)

Skill Enhancement Course (SEC):

- Students of BA(Prog) and B.Sc.(Prog) will opt for any one SEC course from the pool of SEC courses offered by the College, except the SEC studied by the students in previous Semesters. (1,2,3,4,5, or 6).
- Students of all courses preferably choose the SEC paper from their parent department.
- NOTE: It is the responsibility of students to ensure that they do not opt for any SEC paper already studied by them in previous Semesters (1, 2, 3, 4, 5, or 6).

1. For allotment to courses with high demand the college will adopt the policy of "first-come-first-serve". If a student fails to submit the online form by the notified date, student will be allotted a course at the discretion of the college.
2. The college reserves the right to change the allocation of seats per paper, or cancel any paper, without prior notice. The decision of the college in this regard will be final and binding.
3. Form will be submitted ONLY ONCE. No request for change of papers will be accepted after the form submission.
4. The students are advised to go through the guidelines and course-wise eligibility criteria/pre-requisite of the course (if any) before opting for the respective elective papers.
5. The selection of the elective papers is entirely provisional and is subject to administrative approval after technical/academic assessment.
6. Classes of optional papers have been already scheduled since the start of the academic session. Students are advised to start attending their chosen papers as per the Time table uploaded on the college website.
